#### DECLARATION OF EASEMENTS

THIS DECLARATION made and declared this 31st day of December, 1979, by Gerald J. Smith and Associates, Inc., a Minnesota corporation, and The Gorgen Co., a Minnesota corporation, hereinafter referred to as Declarants,

#### WITHESSETH:

WHEREAS, Declarants are the owners of the entirety of the premises described on Exhibit "A" attached hereto and being in Anoka County, Minnesota, and,

WHEREAS, it is desirable to declare and establish the various following easements for the benefit of individual owners, the owners within the premises referred to in Exhibit "A" above.

NOW, THEREFORE, the following easements are hereby declared to exist in perpetuum, and shall run with the burdened and benefited land.

### A. PRIVATE DRIVEWAY EASEMENTS.

Private Driveway Easements for ingress and egress, including vehicular access and turning of vehicles (but not per parking or storage of vehicles) over each of the specified easement descriptions set forth in Exhibit "C" attached hereto. Each easement shall be located upon the parcels described as servient

parcel and shall be in favor of the parcels described as the dominant parcels. The easements shall run with the land and shall be appurtenant to the dominant parcels. Additionally, each lot shall, as to a lot immediately adjoining and as to which it shares a driveway, enjoy backing and turning privilege over so much of a vehicular pad as is located more than 20 feet from garage door of the dwelling upon such immediately adjoining lot.

### B. UNDERGROUND UTILITY EASEMENTS.

An easement for general utility (i.e. sewer and water service) purposes to Coon Rapids, to the Association, or any other appropriate public authority or utility for maintenance of underground sewer and water lines, along with full access thereto and to any and all above ground connections thereon located, running from public street to building lines and specifically as set forth and described upon Exhibit "D" attached hereto and made a part hereof;

## GENERAL PROVISIONS

Each of the foregoing easements shall be interpreted and construed in such fashion as will most nearly accord with the general purposes and plan of development set forth in the Master Declaration. If any of the utility easements herein described shall in fact fall short of meeting actual building lines as intended and as originally constructed, or shall in fact encroach upon building lines as originally constructed, the building lines shall in fact control over the dimensions herein expressed. The utility easements herein specified are superior to the private easements in that entitled authority shall have full right to excavate as necessary for repair and maintenance.
